

About The Fund

The Montgomery Area Community Club (MACC) is committed to ensuring the longevity of the Montgomery Kolacky Royalty Scholarships. In 2023, the MACC worked with the Southern Minnesota Initiative Foundation (SMIF) to establish an affiliated fund as a way to raise funds for an Endowed Scholarship. The fund will support our Royalty in their pursuit for further education and will continue to impact lives for generations to come.

What is an Endowed Scholarship Fund?

A scholarship endowment is a perpetual source of support with the sole purpose of creating a sustainable continuation of the Montgomery Kolacky Royalty Scholarships. A donor who gives us a donation today shall expect that the gift will support these scholarships 100 years from now. These monies will be housed and maintained for this purpose and will be considered permanently restricted.



Does the Endowed Scholarship Fund provide tax benefits?

As an affiliated fund of the Southern Minnesota Initiative Foundation, a non-profit 501 (c) (3) tax exempt organization, all donations are tax deductible as allowed by law.


How does the Endowed Scholarship Fund grow?

The gifts placed within the fund will be considered permanently restricted and will remain in the fund. Through the appreciation of these gifts, MACC will have access to the earnings to payout towards the Montgomery Kolacky Royalty Scholarships. The endowment is housed with SMIF who will provide oversight and management of the fund. Other forms of funds besides cash can be accepted.
