# **Hobby Stock and Improved Stock Tractor Rules**

Hot Farm and Pro Farm rules available separately

### **General Rules:**

- 1. Tractor may be 200 pounds over with driver. Scale on site.
- 2. Driver must be 18 years of age or at least 16 years of age with parent's written consent.
- 3. No pressurized fuels, nitrous oxide or other oxidizing agents.
- 4. Limit of two hooks per tractor.
- 5. Tractor must have hitch hole or quarter turn clevis at least 3 inches in diameter. Pulling point not more than 20 inches high and at least 18 inches behind center of axle.
- 6. Hitch must be rigid in all directions. No pulling from two or three point hitches.
- 7. All added weight must be fastened securely. Rear weight may not interfere with hooking of sled.
- 8. Loss of any object while hooked to sled may result in disqualification.
- 9. Driver must stop immediately upon signal from judge. Pull is over when forward motion stops.
- 10. Tractor must be in neutral when hooked and unhooked.
- 11. Driver is allowed one restart before 100 feet.
- 12. Pull will terminate if contestant runs out of bounds.
- 13. Driver will remain seated at all times.
- 14. Hood, grill, and fan shroud must be in place.
- 15. Driver must be present at drivers meeting at 2:10 p.m.

- 4. Tractor must run on fuel for which engine was originally equipped. No dry blocks.
- 5. No "V" or double cut tires, top cut allowed. No aluminum frame or chassis components. Aluminum front wheels allowed.

### **Improved Stock Non-Turbo Rules:**

- 1. No turbocharger or supercharger allowed. No rpm limit.
- 2. Engine block and crankcase must be the same length, number of cylinders and make as stock.
- Engine must run on gasoline, E85, or diesel fuel.

### **Improved Stock Turbocharged Rules:**

- 1. Single turbocharger allowed with maximum size 2.25 inch intake. No rpm limit.
- 2. Engine must be 410 cubic inch displacement (CID) or less. Water injection allowed.
- No inline fuel injection pumps allowed. Engine must run on diesel fuel, gasoline, or E85.
- Tractor must have wheelie bars and wide front axle. No "V" or double cut tires.

16. Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry. 17. Failure to allow inspection by judges will result in disqualification. **Hobby Stock Rules (Trophy Only Class):** 1. Tractor speed will be regulated. 2. No turbocharger unless originally equipped. 3. Must have stock block, crankcase, head, manifolds, and carburetor or injection pump for that model tractor.

### **General Rules:**

- 1. Tractor may be 200 pounds over with driver. Scale on site.
- 2. Driver must be 18 years of age or at least 16 years of age with parent's written consent.
- 3. No pressurized fuels, nitrous oxide or other oxidizing agents.
- 4. Limit of two hooks per tractor.
- 5. Tractor must have hitch hole or quarter turn clevis at least 3 inches in diameter. Pulling point not more than 20 inches high and at least 18 inches behind center of axle.
- 6. Hitch must be rigid in all directions. No pulling from two or three point hitches.
- 7. All added weight must be fastened securely. Rear weight may not interfere with hooking of sled.
- 8. Loss of any object while hooked to sled may result in disqualification.
- 9. Driver must stop immediately upon signal from judge. Pull is over when forward motion stops.
- 10. Tractor must be in neutral when hooked and unhooked.
- 11. Driver is allowed one restart before 100 feet.
- 12. Pull will terminate if contestant runs out of bounds.
- 13. Driver will remain seated at all times.
- 14. Hood and grill must be in place.
- 15. Driver must be present at drivers meeting at 2:10 p.m.
- 16. Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 17. Failure to allow inspection by judges will result in disqualification.

# State Hwy 13 ROAD CLOSED Between New Prague & Montgomery

### Hot Farm Safety Rules (May not exceed 10 mph unless meets all Hot Farm Safety Rules):

- 1. Engine must have steel flywheel and electrical fan or no fan.
- 2. Engine must have an air shut off that can be activated by the sled. Air shut off must be mechanically activated.
- 3. Tractor must have roll over protection with seat belt, wheelie bars and wide front axle.

### **Hot Farm Competition Rules:**

- 1. 10,500 Hot Farm Stock appearing fuel injection pump and 2.6 inch maximum inlet turbocharger. Engine block must be from a 466 cubic inch or smaller engine.
- 2. 13,000 Hot Farm Inline P pumps and 3.0" max inlet turbo allowed.
- 3. Single turbocharger only. No RPM limit.
- 4. Engine must run on gasoline or diesel fuel only.

### **Pro Farm Rules:**

1. Tractor must meet NTPA pro farm rules.

## Truck & Semi Rules

### **General Rules:**

- 1. Truck may be 200 pounds over with driver. Scale on site.
- 2. Driver must be 18 years of age or at least 16 years of age with parent's written consent.
- 3. No tire chains, pressurized fuels, nitrous oxide, or other oxidizing agents. Water injection is allowed.
- 4. Limit of two hooks per pickup. If jumping up a class, may be exempted from that class's safety rules; but must meet the original class's safety rules.
- 5. Truck must have hitch hole or quarter turn clevis at least 3 inches in diameter. Pulling point not more than 26 inches high (20 inches for semi class). Hitch must be rigid in all directions.
- 6. 35-inch maximum tires on single rear wheel pickups. 33-inch max tires on dual real wheel pickups.
- 7. All vehicles must have working brakes.
- 8. All added weight must be fastened securely.
- 9. Loss of any object while hooked to sled may result in disqualification.
- 10. Front weight may not extend more than 60 inches from the center of the front axle.
- 11. Driver must stop immediately upon signal from judge. Pull is over when forward motion stops.
- 12. Truck must be in neutral when hooked and unhooked.
- 13. Driver is allowed one restart before 100 feet.
- 14. Pull will terminate if contestant runs out of bounds.
- 15. Driver must be present at drivers meeting at 2:10 p.m.
- 16. Promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- 17. Failure to allow inspection by judges will result in disqualification.

10 to 12 entries - pay 4 places

13 to 15 entries - pay 5 places

### **Street Modified Diesel Rules:**

- 1. Vehicle must appear to be street legal. Exhaust must exit behind the driver. No hanging weights.
- 2. Stock appearing turbo in OEM configuration including piping. Stock cover and 64mm maximum compressor wheel. No twin turbo's unless factory equipped. No dual fuels or aluminum heads.
- 3. Stock suspension only. Traction bars allowed.

### **Open Diesel Rules:**

- 1. DOT tires required.
- 2. Drive shaft loops and kill switch required.
- 3. No dual fuels or aluminum heads.

### **Street Modified Gas Rules:**

- 1. Vehicle must appear to be street legal. Exhaust must exit behind the driver.
- 2. No dual fuels or aluminum heads.

### **Super Stock Rules:**

- 1. DOT tires required.
- 2. Drive shaft loops and kill switch required.
- 3. Engines limited to 530 cubic inches

### **Semi-Tractor Rules:**

1. Hitch height is 20 inches or less
