JUDGING CRITERIA

Windows will be judged on the following:

- Overall appearance and attractiveness
- Use of acknowledging the theme "ALL THINGS CZECH"
- Creativity and originality
- Signage: The window should have a sign or window paint that reads “Kolacky Days – July 26 - 28” that can be read from the street. The Montgomery Area Community Club can provide you with a FREE Kolacky Days sign for your window – just let us know!

- Windows should remain decorated throughout the Kolacky Days celebration. The display may be removed on Monday, July 29 or thereafter.
